Dr. Greenland's current research relates to causes of atrial fibrillation, peripheral arterial disease, heart disease in women after adverse pregnancy outcomes, and precision medicine. Dr. Greenland is an elected Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians (London), the American Heart Association, the American College of Cardiology, and the European Society of Cardiology.
