Dr. Wei is Professor of Dermatology at the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF) and Staff Physician at the San Francisco VA Health Care System. She is Director of the UCSF Melanoma Surveillance Clinic and the Helen Diller Family Comprehensive Cancer Center Genetics/Familial Cancer Syndrome Clinic. Her current research is focused on disorders of the skin that are modulated by environmental exposures and genetics, such as melanoma and atopic dermatitis. Her research group is studying the effects of air pollution on disorders such as atopic dermatitis. Her group is also using artificial intelligence and machine learning to develop novel methods to screen for and diagnose skin cancers, with the goals of increasing access to skin screening exams and increasing the accuracy of skin screening.
