Dr. Ong is Associate Professor of Clinical Pediatrics at the Keck School of Medicine at the University of Southern California at Los Angeles and has been attending physician in the Division of Clinical Immunology and Allergy at Children's Hospital in Los Angeles since 2004. In addition, he is Consulting Allergist at the Engemann Student Health Center at the University of Southern California at Los Angeles. He is board certified in pediatrics and allergy and immunology.

Dr. Ong received his medical degree from the Loma Linda University School of Medicine in Loma Linda, California, followed by a residency at White Memorial Medical Center in Los Angeles. Additional postgraduate training included a fellowship in allergy and immunology at National Jewish Health in Denver, Colorado.

Dr. Ong's main areas of research interest include atopic dermatitis, food allergy, and asthma. He is the recipient of NIH, foundation and industry grants to support his research, which currently involves studies on the prediction of atopic dermatitis, infection, and allergy, and the Atopic Dermatitis Research Network. As a recognized expert, he has been an active lecturer and serves on numerous panels for national and international organizations, including the NIH, the European Academy of Allergy and Clinical Immunology, the National Eczema Association, the Asthma and Allergy Foundation of America, and the American College of Allergy, Asthma and Immunology. His work has appeared in a number of peer-reviewed articles and book chapters.

Dr. Ong is a fellow of the American College of Allergy, Asthma and Immunology, the American Academy of Pediatrics, and AAAAI. He was recognized in *Best Doctors in America* from 2011 to 2018 and cited in Los Angeles magazine's *Super Doctors* listings from 2010 to 2019.
