Dr. Siegfried is affiliated with Saint Louis University and Cardinal Glennon Children's Hospital, where she is Professor of Pediatrics and Dermatology and Director of the Division of Pediatric Dermatology.

Dr. Siegfried received her medical degree from the University Missouri at Columbia and completed residencies at the University of Iowa Hospital and Clinics in Iowa City. She is board certified in pediatrics, dermatology, and pediatric dermatology.

Her current practice includes all aspects of caring for children with congenital and acquired skin problems, with an emphasis on severe inflammatory skin disease. She specializes in treatments for atopic dermatitis, eczema, psoriasis, and vascular birthmarks. She has been a principal investigator for various industry-sponsored clinical trials in these areas, leading to advancements in pediatric drug development. Her reputation is internationally recognized: she is a frequently invited lecturer and thought leader for major organizations in her field. She is the author of more than 100 original papers, book chapters, and abstracts on her research, and she serves on the editorial board of *Dermatology Times*.

A member of several professional organizations, Dr. Siegfried served as a member of the American Board of Dermatology and subsequently became president of the Board of Directors. From 1994 to 2019, Dr. Siegfried has been recognized as one of Woodward White's *Best Doctors in America*.
